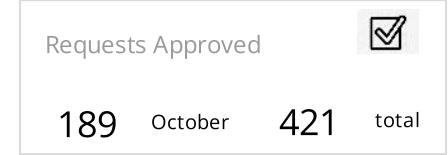
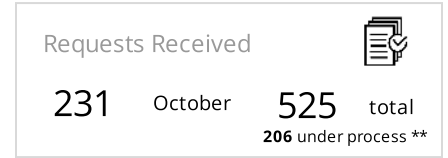
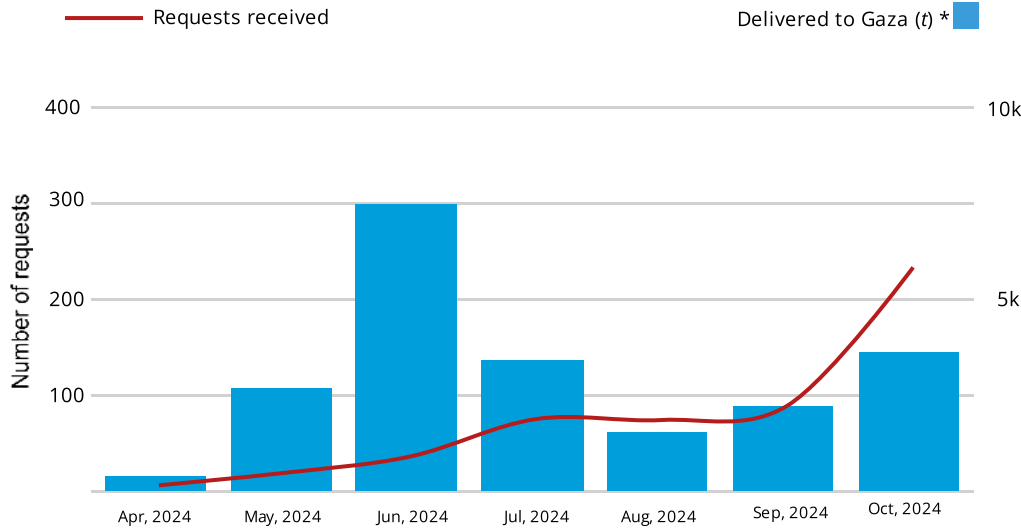


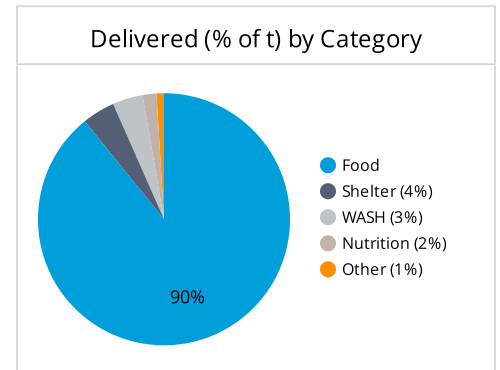
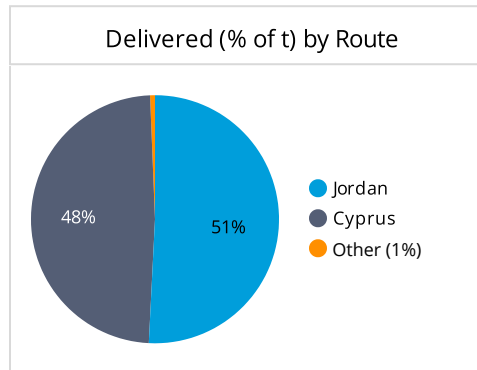
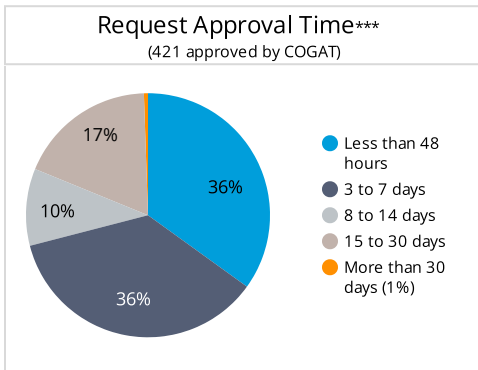
UN 2720 Mechanism for Gaza

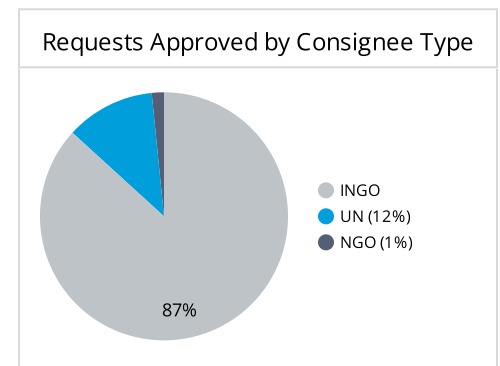
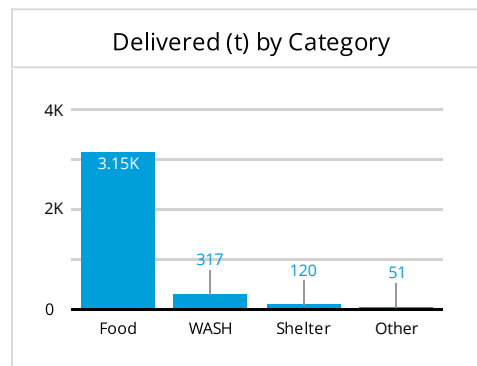
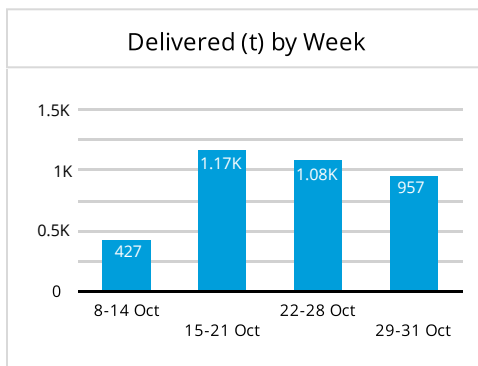


In October 2024, 3.6K t of humanitarian aid processed through the UN2720 Mechanism was delivered to Gaza. This is a 38% increase from September 2024 (2.6K t) and a 3% increase compared to the monthly average since May 2024 (3.5K t). Humanitarian aid convoys to Gaza from Jordan stalled after 28 September 2024 following changes in Israeli customs requirements. Aid convoys resumed on 10 October 2024.

[UN Security Council Resolution 2720 \(2023\)](#) mandated the establishment of the UN 2720 Mechanism for Gaza with the objective of accelerating the provision of humanitarian relief consignments to Gaza. The UN Office for Project Services (UNOPS) supports the Senior Humanitarian and Reconstruction Coordinator for Gaza (SHRC) in the operationalisation of the UN 2720 Mechanism for Gaza. Data collection for the Cyprus Maritime Corridor route started on 26 April 2024. Data collection for the Jordan Corridor route started on 1 July 2024. This report presents data on aid delivered to Gaza through the UN 2720 Mechanism, not the totality of aid to Gaza. All data as of 31 October 2024.
